## 1. Market status of e-Learning

### ■ Overall market size (unit : millions US \$)

| 1999 | 2000 | 2001  | 2002  | 2003  |
|------|------|-------|-------|-------|
| 683  | 833  | 1,167 | 1,417 | 2,083 |

- Per Sector annual average Growth rate: Contents(48%), System(37%), Learning Service(11%)
- The number of e-Learning company is about 500

### ■ e-Learning in Enterprises

- 10.7% of enterprises adopted e-Learning among the 1,593 enterprises (Enterprises 39.7%, SME 4.7%, Nov. 2002)

### ■ 16 Cyber Universities

- 87 departments, total enrollment: 23,850

## 2. Law and Regulation regarding e-Learning

### ■ K12 Act / High Education Act

- Providing e-Learning contents to K12 classes
- e-Campus Vision 2007(2003-2007, Ministry of Education)

### ■ Life-long education Act

- Korea Open University applies diverse learning systems and educational programs such as the internet, cable TV, Radio, etc
- Cyber Universities approved by Ministry of Education

### ■ Vocational Training Promotion Act.

- Internet Communication Training System adopted in 1999
- Promoting to utilize e-Learning in companies

### ■ Act for HR support of SME(enacted in Sep. 2003)

- Support for e-Learning in SME

- \* Prevention of discrimination on e-Learning

- **e-Learning Industry Development Committee**

- ▶ Minister of Government Policy Coordination, 8 Vice Ministers, Private experts,

- **Supporting for infrastructure of the e-Learning Industry**

- ▶ Supporting for Cultivating of e-Learning specialists

- ▶ Supporting standards and R&D on e-Learning

- **Supporting for utilizing of e-Learning in all sector**

- ▶ Promoting to utilize e-Learning in enterprises

- ▶ Supporting e-Learning and establishing e-Learning center at local areas

- ▶ Promoting to adopt e-Learning in public sector for educational training

### ■ **Standardization**

- Korea ISO/IEC JTC1 SC36(April '00, Agency for Technology and Standards)  
Joined as Plenary member in ISO/IEC JTC1 SC36(Jul. 2002)
- Hosted "8th Plenary Meeting of ISO/IEC JTC1 SC36 (Seoul, Sep. 2003)
- e-Learning standardization forum at a non-governmental level(July. 2003)
  - ▶ Four fields: contents, system, learning environment and research
  - ▶ Specialists in education and business field take part in the forum

### ■ **R&D**

- Roadmap for the development of e-Learning technologies (April. 2003)
- Supporting key technology programs to promote the growth of e-Learning industry

### 3. Supporting for e-Learning Industry

#### ■ Nursing e-Learning specialists

- Supporting training in enterprises via ‘e-Learning support center’
  - ▶ established in May 2003, e-Learning Industry Association
- Supporting departments related to e-learning in colleges
  - ▶ revision of curriculum, cooperation with industries

#### ■ Conducting the content quality certification

- 70 contents are certified by Korea Association of Cyber Education from may 2002

### 4. Utilizing e-Learning for HRD

#### ■ Government Official Online Academy

- Offering 21 courses based on e-Learning(2003)

#### ■ Internet Training Program for worker

- Trainee: 20,000(1999) → 57,000(2002) / Course: 223(1999) → 2,985(2002)

#### ■ Online Technological Training Center

- Employee in SMEs, offering 6 courses

#### ■ e-Business Woman Cyber Academy

- Women specialists in e-business, offering 2 courses(2003)

#### ■ Online Training Center at local Governments

- Local authorities conduct IT education through on-line
