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E-Learning-1

- Concept of e-learning
 - Educational institutions on web based learning
 - Stages of development: primary, secondary to tertiary
- Objectives of e-learning
 - Collaboration
 - Proof of concept: ICT pervasiveness
 - Structured delivery, enhanced learning
 - Blended learning: complementary classroom
- Any where, any path, any time and any alternatives
- Contents, contexts, collaborations and communications are key to e-learning
