# ADL Strategy

- Work closely with industry, government, and academia to promote common, open international specifications and standards that will enable reuse and interoperability of learning content
- Promote widespread collaboration that can satisfy common needs
- Enhance performance with emerging learning technologies
- Promote a coordinated implementation process with incentives for organizational and cultural change

- ▶ “enlightened self-interest” at work

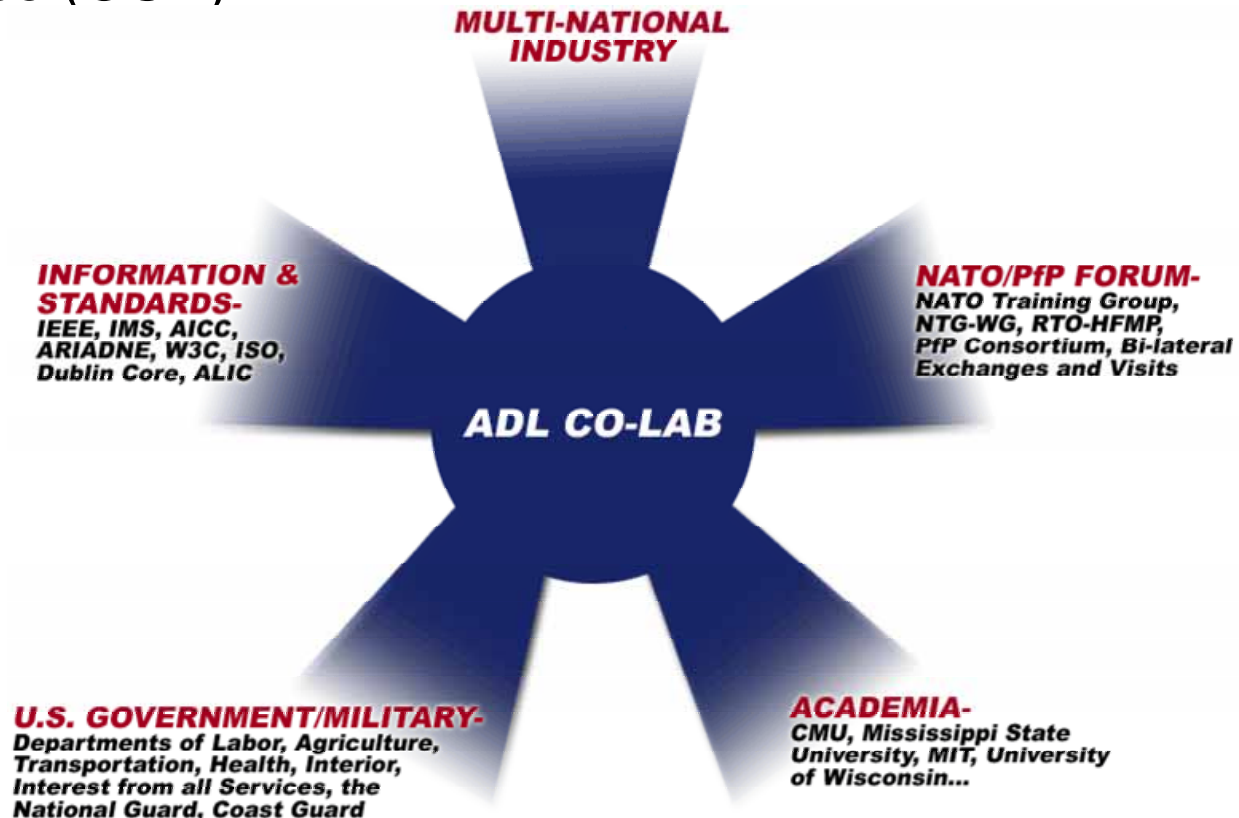


- An open collaborative environment for sharing learning technology research, development, and assessments. The Co-Lab goals are to:

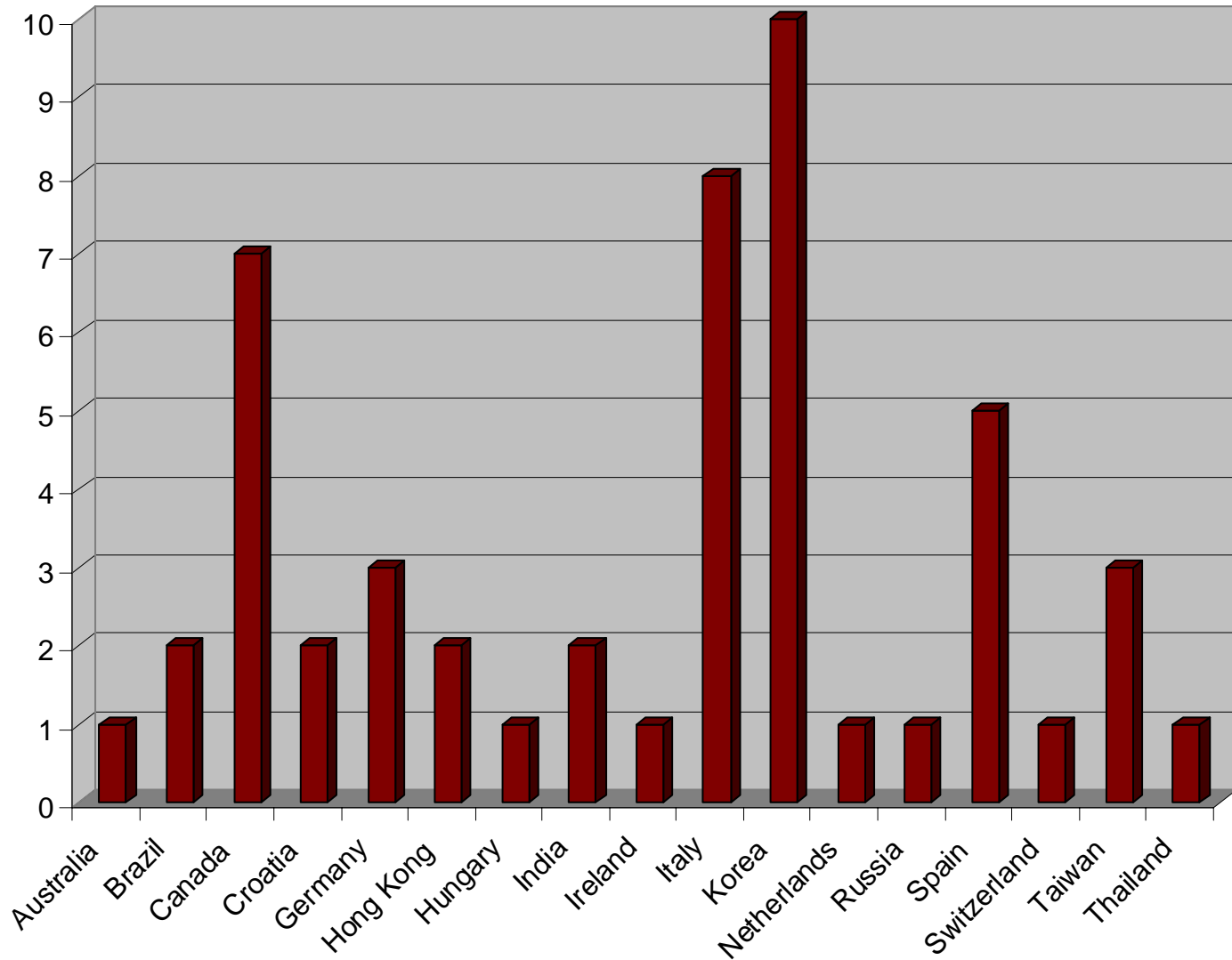

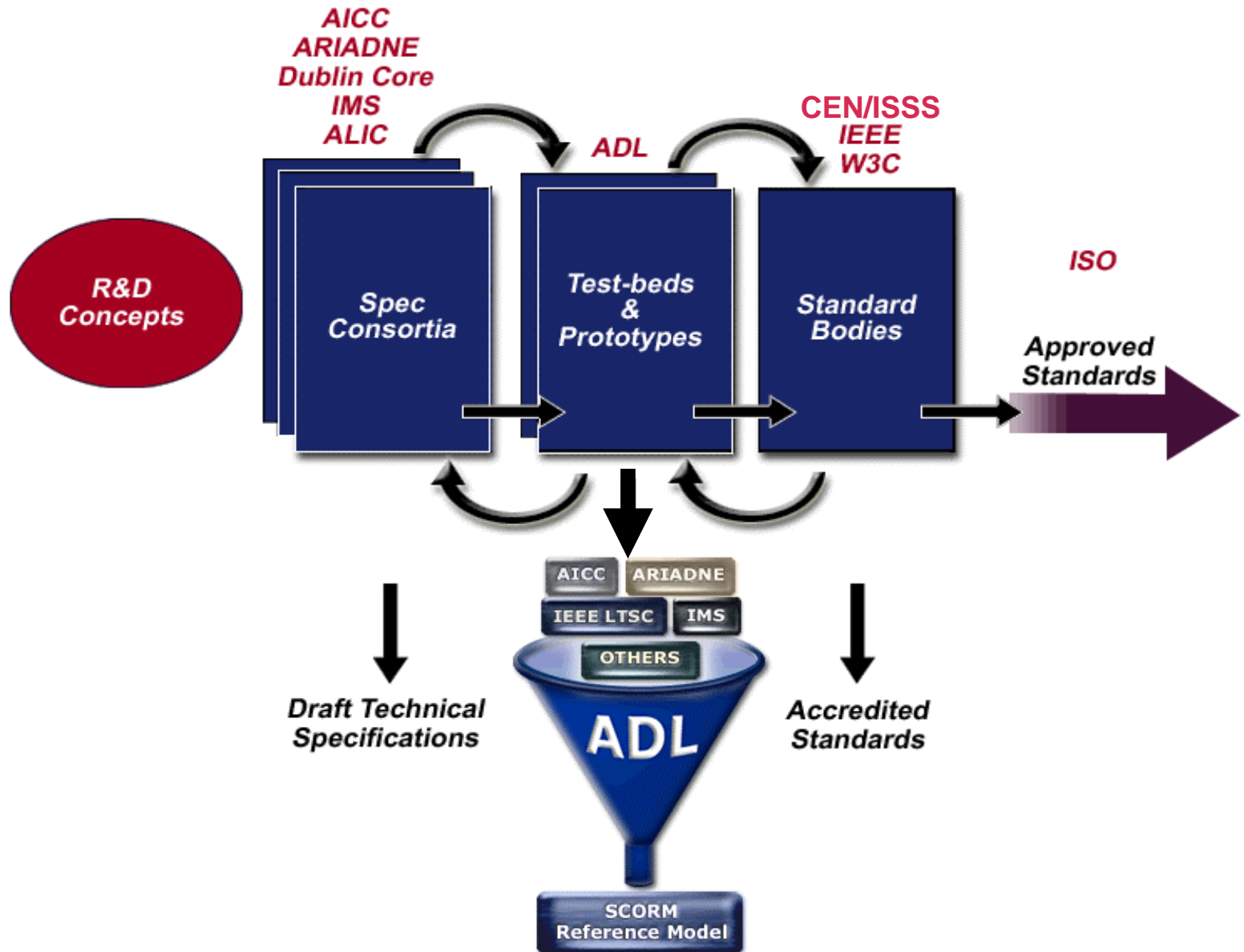
