 - "SCORM" now is quite familiar

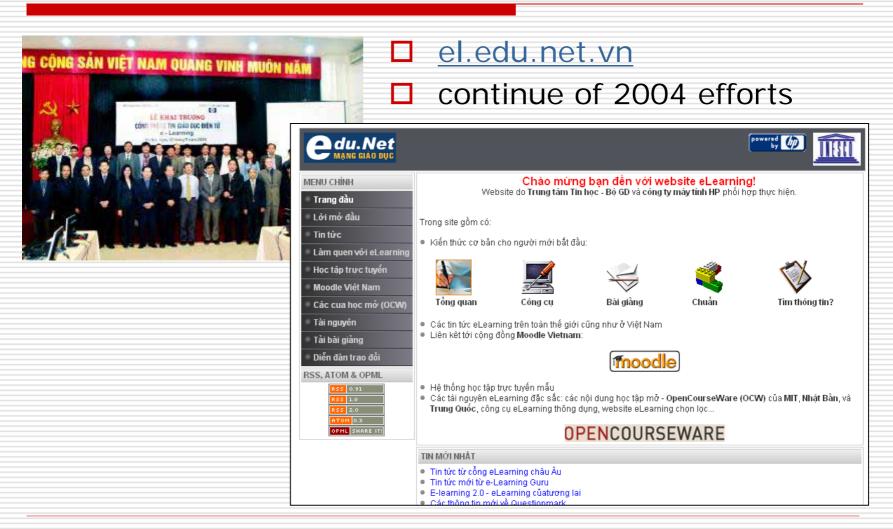
current picture demand appears

- example: Prudential
 - largest insurance company with 40,000 staffs
 - in purchasing LMS for in-house training
 - main concern is how to create contents
- example: Hanoi University of Education
 - 30,000 students
 - using Moodle (http://elearning.dhsphn.edu.vn)
 - need computer-based exam system since year 2006

current picture demand appears

- a little success story: Van Lang University
 - not big success, but some progress
 - using LMS and IT Engineers Skill Standards contents for IT Faculty (www.dhdlvanlang.edu.vn)
 - results:
 - noticeable improvement of student's IT and English skills
 - noticeable improvement of lecturer's and mentor's capabilities

current picture of MOET e-learning portal



current picture companies withdrew

- biggest online provider (truongthi.com.vn) suspended for 2 years, cannot restart
 - affected by financial/transaction infrastructure
 - affected by intellectual property issues
 - affected by technical issues
- at least 2 producers withdrew
 - cost of producing exceed estimation, due to unexpected difficulties in implementing SCORM
 - market growth is not as fast as expected

challenges

- last year challenges
 - lack of contents
 - lack of e-Learning professionals: teachers don't know how to use e-Learning tools
 - small budget
 - e-Learning experts training
 - ICT infrastructure

challenges what has been solved

- not solved at 100%, but remarkable
- budget for universities
 - procurement started
- □ ICT infrastructure
 - number of ADSL and mobile phone subscribers increased dramatically
 - □ 200K ADSL subscriber (300% to 2004)
 - □ 5.5M mobile phone subscribers (130% to 2004)
- Internet using society growth with booming of online game services

challenges what still remains

- biggest challenge is contents and how to create contents
 - affected to decision of purchasing system in universities and enterprises
- operation model of providers (in-house and online/businees providers)
- □ lack of e-Learning professionals
 - need training for teachers and experts
- □ ICT infrastructure
 - QoS

what will happen in future

- in-house and online/business providers will look for contents and tools for creating contents to use with freeware LMS, or donated LMS
 - most concerned is content
- most of providers will purchase turn-key LMS/LCMS/tools for trial phase of their system's deployment
 - "try and fail" period for operation model

what will happen in future (cont.)

- standard (such as SCORM) is important, but not at first priority
 - availability of SCORM compliant content/tool will affect providers' decision of choosing

what will happen in future our efforts

- continue of 2005 plan
 - spreading basic e-Learning knowledge to Universities, Schools, Companies, Government.
 - developing/localizing own e-Learning tools based on OSSes.
 - promoting cooperation with e-Learning organizations and companies in ASEAN+4.
 - AEN2004 Conference and WGs meetings Results/Experiences to Vietnam.

what will happen in future our efforts

- the most importance: content and modus operandi
 - promoting collaboration for guidelines of creating content
 - promoting collaboration for guidelines of defining operation/business model
 - promoting content creation and using of content creating tools, especially SCORM conformant
